

Short Stay Home for Women in Distress

Project Swarajya started the anti-trafficking campaign as a partner of Jajnyaseni Anti Trafficking Network since 2003. Then came up the Swarajya Short Stay Home with 30 members capacity in 2007 at Kendrapada in collaboration with Central Social Welfare Board. Now it is functioning at Barimul in Kendrapada. The inmates of the home are being trained in various trades like Agarbati making, Toy making and Tailoring and they sell these items in different exhibitions organized by district and state administrations on various occasions.
